## Explanations

**President:** President is the leader of the country.

**Prime Minister – Government:** Prime Minister is the head of the government. Government is the group of people with the authority to govern a country or state.

**Minister – Ministry:** Ministry is a government department headed by a minister.

**Member of Parliament – Parliament:** Parliament is the country's legislative (law-making) body.

**Mayor – Municipality:** Municipality is the local government of a town or a district. Mayor is the head of municipality.

**Political Party:** Political party is an organised group of people with similar political aims and opinions, that seeks to influence public policy by getting its candidates elected to public office.

**Regional governor - regional government:** Regional government is the authority that governs a region/state inside a country. Regional governor is the head of the regional government.

**Ombudsman:** Ombudsman is an official, usually appointed by the government, who investigates complaints of citizens against businesses, financial institutions, universities, government departments, or other public entities

**International organisation:** International Organisation is an interstate or non-state union based on agreements.

**Media – Journalist:** Journalist is a person who writes for newspapers, magazines, or news websites or prepares news to be broadcast. Media is the main means of mass communication.

**Social media influencer:** People who have large audiences of followers on their social media accounts.

**Civil society – NGOs:** A non-profit organization that operates independently of any government, typically one whose purpose is to address a social or political issue.
